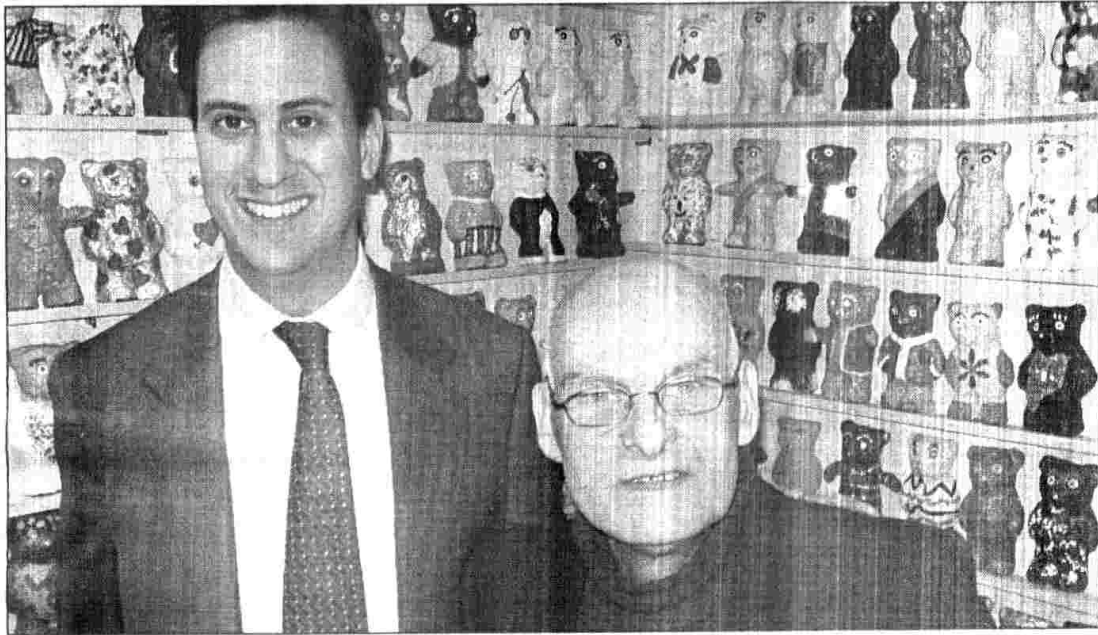


ED MILIBAND STRESSES THE BEAR NECESSITIES
